While we await the release of the final agenda items, I'd like to share with you a story. In the mid-90's, when I was first graced with lasting sobriety, a long-timer had taken me under his wing. He was called Doc. He had served in WWII aboard a ship in the Pacific for which I know few details. Several years prior to my arrival, Doc had helped start a popular Friday night speaker

meeting in the city of Orange. In the mid-90's, there were a few long-timers who attended this meeting on a regular basis. Doc never governed the meeting, but was quick to take control if ever a situation presented itself. Yes, I think it would be safe to say, we were afraid of Doc and the other long-timers there. Yet we respected them immensely. One Friday night, I remember

catching him near the literature table. He was quietly expressing the importance of Conference approved literature to me. I had no idea what 'Conference approved' meant, but I sensed that it was something important. In his manner of tone, I intuitively understood that this was literature, approved or endorsed by AA somehow.

I had begun to attend this Friday night meeting on my third day of sobriety, and over the course of weeks; many things began to impact me. One of those things was a G.S.R. report which was given once a month.



I found myself beginning to look forward to his report every month. Something about it made me feel safe, even though I did not understand it.

A few years later, a friend of mine became a G.S.R. for a meeting, though it was not for this particular Friday night meeting. One Friday night, our G.S.R. was absent and my friend volunteered to give a report on their behalf. He spoke of a delegate going to New York to attend and represent us at a conference. This sounded vague to me, but something about the way he said it stayed with me. I knew it was something important, but yet I was confused. It would take several years of involvement for me to put two and two together; that the conference my friend spoke of was the 'Conference' in Conference approved literature.

Today I am a Delegate to the Conference. Doc is no longer with us. He has joined the big meeting in the sky. How I wish I could go back in time, to meet Doc at the literature table and to tell him, "Doc! I'm going to be a part of the Conference!" I cannot imagine how proud he would be. He would not be proud for status or power, as we have none. He would be proud to know that the Conference he revered so much, I will be a part of, doing my small but important part, that of carrying the message of hope to the alcoholic who still suffers.
