Presentation: Motion making Process in Area 09, Jeryl T. Past Area 09 Delegate, Panel 62

- Motions keep order
- Motions should be well thought out and presented well
- Once a motion is made and seconded, and re-stated by the chair, it belongs to the group
- A motion dies if it is not seconded, it is rescinded, or it is tabled and not picked up again
- Substantial unanimity is necessary to pass a motion
- Minority opinion always has the chance to be heard
- If the minority opinion changed even one person's mind, there needs to be a motion to reconsider the vote. If the majority opinion is affirmative to reconsider, then discussion begins all over again
- "Calling the question" means "time to vote"
- The first ASC is to present motions, the second ASC is to discuss and ask questions. The Assembly is where we vote on motions
- Turning an ASC into an Assembly should only be done in time-sensitive, emergent situations
- Bring Area motions from the ASC to your District, so the GSRs can bring to the groups
- Decisions can take time in AA
- Chair maintains order by having no opinion, receiving all discussion graciously, and being willing to keep discussion focussed on the motion at hand
- When we practice "disorder" we get good at it. Stay diligent in practicing the proper motion process
- Read, study and prepare as DCMC. Always have bylaws and guidelines with you in meetings
