

Mid-Southern California Area 09  
Guidelines for General Service Representative (GSR) School  
Approved by MSCA Assembly 01/09/2022

I. Statement of Purpose:

The purpose of the MSCA 09 GSR School is to introduce to all new General Service Representatives (GSRs), Alternate GSRs, and any other AA members, the structure of AA General Service and the duties of a GSR.

II. Membership:

Membership is open to all MSCA 09 GSRs, Alternate GSRs, and any AA members seeking the basic information of AA General Service.

III. GSR School Structure:

The MSCA 09 GSR School is a meeting where new GSRs, new Alternate GSRs, and any other AA members are suggested to attend. It is led by the chairperson of the school. There is a English speaking Chair and a Spanish speaking Chair. Both are voting members of the Area Service Committee (ASC) and the Area Assembly.

IV. Qualifications:

- a. Completion of a full (2 year) term as a GSR or any other General Service commitment.
- b. Ability to lead a meeting with the knowledge and experience of The General Service Structure, The General Service Manuel and the 12 Traditions and the 12 Concepts.

V. Duties and Responsibilities:

- a. Conduct the MSCA 09 GSR School to provide helpful information to GSRs, Alternate GSRs, and any other interested members.
- b. Complete a MSCA 09 GSR School report for each MSCA 09 meeting. It should be done in person at each meeting. However it can also be sent to the MSCA Secretary via email to the MSCA Website
- c. Annually, review the Committee Guidelines. Also submit an annual budget to the Finance Committee.
- d. Recommended to try to attend AA District meetings and other AA events in the MSCA Area.
