- Jerry discussed- AA needs YOU! Available Service Opportunities in District 8: DCM's for Sub Dist. B, C, E & F; Committee chair for Accessibilities, CEC, H & I, CPC and Intergroup Liaison. Please raise your hand if interested. Please announce at your meetings
- 2. Update report on District 8 Ad Hoc Committee no report tonight.
- 3. Update report on Ad Hoc committee to create a District website. **Aaron B.** states she has no update tonight and check back next month. **Kris C.** states he has some experience with this and volunteered to work with **Aran** and committee to get website work done. Some discussion and questions were answered and committee is seeking volunteers and is in the early stages of work.
- 4. **Ron W.** reviewed last month's motion on new bank account and reported that he and **Jerry** will go forward in opening the new bank account with the new tax ID number as approved in June's meeting. Questions answered.
- 5. Update report on Ad Hoc committee on District Treasurer and Treasury guidelines.
 - **Cindy V.** reviews the Ad Hoc's Final draft of Treasurer/Treasury Guidelines and the goal being an obligation to give clear guidelines for the treasurer and the district's responsibility for the group's 7th tradition contributions. Copies available tonight and were sent by Jerry as an e-blast.
 - Prudent reserve amount was increased to \$6000 going forward to cover the district's overhead and operating expenses, including rent, etc.
 - Questions and comments were heard:

- a concern about distribution of excess funds over prudent reserve and this not leaving enough money to cover expenses if we start at a zero balance;
- we could spend a crazy amount of time trying to discuss and agree on how to spend the money; is it militant to make this mandatory?
- important to find ways to spend money locally, to not usurp the individual group's decisionmaking process; perhaps ask groups not to send money for a while if we have too much; if we do this it is hard to reverse the trend back when we need money; it is important we do not operate out of fear; groups decide the percentages to contribute their 7th tradition money;
- important to take the draft guidelines back to your group for discussion and return to next month's meeting with ideas, questions, and any feedback your group may have.
- The Ad Hoc committee reviewed and feels it is important to review available AA literature on this subject at aa.org to ensure we are good stewards of our group's contributions-Pamphlets: P17 "AA Tradition- How it Developed by Bill W. (pages 4, 8, 27, 32, 50, discuss money); "Where Money and Spirituality Mix"; "The AA Group Treasurer"; and Service Manual financial information are a few resources available to review.
